Position title: ArtZone Assistant

Description: ArtZone is an exciting new program that the Agnes plans to pilot in the fall of 2015, subject to funding. It is a free drop-in after-school program for youth ages 14–18 to be offered in the André Biéler Studio. Local artists will facilitate this program for artistically-inclined youth who want to explore materials, try out new techniques, discuss the art in our inspiring exhibitions and socialize in a safe space. The assistant plays a crucial role in this outreach initiative by helping the artist in facilitating and coaching participants in different art projects, preparing the studio and cleaning up after each session. The assistant will gain knowledge of Agnes exhibitions and experience in interacting with youth.

Term of placement: Fall semester 2015.

Time requirements: Three hours a week, 2:30 to 5:30 pm, Thursdays, from 24 September to 26 November.

Qualifications: Two years toward a Bachelor's Degree in Fine Art or Art History
